15 and 22-24 February 2023



#### First call

The International Carpathian School, winter session, is opening doors to the European Green Deal and cooperation in a hybrid format due to the status of the war in Ukraine. The purpose of the session is to expand networking activities in the Carpathian region aiming at sustainable development of mountainous territorial communities. The session is hosting experts from the Ministry for Environmental protection of Ukraine and the Secretariat of the Carpathian Convention, Vienna, Austria. February 15 session is organized together with the PreMiWaFi project, Sweden. We are welcoming graduate and post-graduate students, early-career practitioners, researchers, civic society activists, and state and local authorities to take part in a remote winter session.
